



- 16 Praise God for the youth of Alliston CRC. Praise God for the Youth Serve Project they were a part of this past year. Praise God that it developed a desire for them to make an impact on their community. Pray for the youth to be equipped through the Holy Spirit to go out into the world with the Good News of Christ.
- 17 Praise God with Georgetown CRC for the young couples in their congregation who are intentionally welcoming others into their church.
- 18 Pray that university and seminary students looking for internships will consider coming to Toronto to engage this delightfully courageous, hospitable, and tough immigrant group.
- 19 Pray with Alliston CRC as they look for a new pastor for their congregation. Ask God to prepare the right person for this role and to guide both the pastor and the congregation to find each other.
- 20 Pray with Georgetown CRC for the small groups in their congregation. Pray that this ministry may grow and that those who participate will grow in their relationship with God.
- 21 Pray for the Christian members of this immigrant group to become connected with, and enfolded by, a local church. Pray that the wounds of war abroad and disputes at home may be healed.
- 22 Praise God with Alliston CRC for the refugees they could sponsor from Rwanda. Praise God for the experience this has been for the refugees and for the congregation.
- 23 Praise God with Georgetown CRC for their partnership with the church plant in Milton. Praise God that this new church is getting started.
- 24 Many parents of this immigrant group are unable to help their children with their homework due to language and literacy issues. Many have requested somebody to come and help their kids in their home. Praise God for those volunteers who go into homes helping children with their homework. Please pray for all the parents whose kids have no helpers at present. Ask God if you should help with this.
- 25 Praise God for the birth of our Saviour, Jesus Christ. Pray that as all of our churches celebrate Christ's birth today we may experience unity, justice and reconciliation as a community of believers.
- 26 Pray for Alliston and Georgetown CRC as many parents in their congregations are grieving that their children are no longer attending church. Pray that these churches may find ways of reaching out to those who have turned away.
- 27 Praise God for the amazing stories of endurance and strength those in the immigrant community have shared with the ministry leaders. Pray for the Christian families who live in this community, and meet weekly to pray for their neighbours, then engage their community in acts of loving service and testimony. Pray for more families to join them and for neighbours to come to know Jesus as well.
- 28 Praise God with Alliston CRC for the healing service they had in October. Praise God that they could really experience communion with God and with each other and experience God's healing through laying on of hands and anointing with oil.
- 29 Pray with Georgetown CRC for marriage relationships in their congregation. Pray that families may be strengthened and may grow in their knowledge and grace of God.
- 30 Please pray for the 50-70 women who gather every am from Monday through Thursday for ESL classes. Students range from never-been-to-school 60m year olds to 25 year old foreign-language Masters Degree holders. Many have requested a lady to come to their home and speak English with them. Please pray that God will send Christian women from the Toronto CRCs to help them.
- 31 Praise God for the past year, for how God has worked in the congregations of Classis Toronto and what God has done in and through our lives. Pray for forgiveness for the things we have not done that we should have. Pray for wisdom and discernment as we face a new year. Pray that Classis Toronto may follow God fully in 2011.
